A look back at the euWater4i-SD Innovation Forum in IFAT

On May 31st, the **first international event of euWater4i-SD**, **the Innovation Forum**, took place as part of IFAT Munich. **More than 60 participants** from all over the world gathered to meet innovative European companies offering water-smart solutions and to learn more about the opportunities of the Latin American and Eastern African water markets.



After a short presentation of euWater4i-SD by Clémence Pierre, **Prof. Michael Braungart** welcomed the participants with a **keynote speech** on "Becoming native to our planet – new challenges and strategies for water management". The main part of the event was dedicated to the **innovative solutions of European companies in water-related fields**. 14 companies from Bulgaria, Czech Republic, France, Germany, the Netherlands and Spain presented themselves, their products and services as well as their international activities in 5-minute pitches.

Finally, the floor was given to **Mr. Philip Storch**, Vice President Sales Management Water at KSB SE & Co. KGaA, to present KSB's activities in Sub-Sahara Africa, as well as to **Mr. Lucas Martins** from Companhia Aguas de Joinville (CAJ) to present the opportunities of the Brazilian water market.

- Network management
- Optimization of the wastewater treatment process
- Knowledge-based management

Participants discussed the topics and presented their solutions in working groups. The event was a successful and fruitful way to **bring together water industry experts to discuss current challenges and network** with each other.

Water4All (Horizon Europe): International opportunities for EU SMEs

The <u>Water4All (Water security for the planet) project</u>, cofunded by the European Union through the Horizon Europe programme, officially started on June 1st, 2022 for seven years. Its general objective is to **stimulate transformations**



in the entire EU Research, Development and Innovation sector in the field of water, especially by promoting the connection between problem owners and solution providers.

In this framework, several actions will be aimed at **fostering international cooperation on waterrelated issues in the RDI and B2B sectors**, and especially developing new tools and new approaches. One of the actions, led by VITO, will consist in organizing **EU workshops during international waterrelated trade shows**. The objective of these workshop will be to allow RDI actors to present their work, but mostly for **EU Tech (especially SMEs) to pitch their solutions and meet users/challenge owners from non-EU countries**. A networking time will also be planned, and potentially matchmaking or B2B sessions between solutions providers and end users/challenge owners.

As France Water Team and Water Alliance are involved in this action, they will each organize one workshop during international water-related fairs between 2022 and 2024: if you have any suggestion of relevant fair or if you wish to contribute, please feel free to contact us!
